

## **Constitution, Compliance and Governance of Groups**

In 2015 the attached document was approved by the Community Council and subsequently validated by Lorraine McGrorty of West Lothian Council. Clause 10 of the Constitution of the Community Council states:

*The community council may appoint representatives to committees of the community council and shall determine their composition, terms of reference, duration, duties and powers.*

- Housing and Social Housing
