

Secretary's Report

1. TTRO - Ochiltree 22 Nov to 4 Dec & 24 Feb to 3 Mar road closure for carriageway repair works. Phase 1 Ogletree Castle to Bridgend junction. Phase 2 Bridgend junction to B8046 (Threemiletown to Ecclesmachon).
2. TTRO – Bonnytoun cottages road closure for drainage works 7 Dec to 21 Dec.
3. TTRO - Station Road – suspension of parking and waiting restrictions from 5 Nov for 18 months.
4. TTRO – High Street from Lion Well Wynd to New Well Wynd (both sides) 26 Oct for 12 months.
5. TTRO – 40mph speed restriction in Bathgate Hills, Hartburn Hills and Bonnytoun farm areas.
6. TTRO - road closures in six phases from Slack End, Torphechien to junction with Ochiltree to Dechmont Road via Cairnpapple and North/South Mains. 11 Jan 2021 for three months.
7. TTRO - closure of footway on the east side of court square and suspension of parking on both sides of court square. 11 Jan - 7 Feb.
8. Spaces for People 30 Nov onwards – cycle lanes St Ninians Road and Edinburgh Road.
9. Manse Road gas main renewal – 12 Oct for 18 weeks
